Details: **An Introduction to Combustible Dust Hazards and OSHA NEP**

Speaker: Dr. Erdem Ural

Speaker Bio: Dr. Erdem A. Ural is a well known combustible dust expert with over 25 years of experience. He has worked on research, litigation, insurance, protection, testing and regulation aspects of combustible dust problems. Dr. Ural is twice the recipient of the Bill Doyle Award for the best paper presentation at the Loss Prevention Symposium. Dr. Ural has published numerous papers in his field, and has been active on a number of national and international committees. He is the chairperson of the ASTM subcommittee for Flammability and Ignitability of Chemicals, Vice-Chair of the ASTM committee for Hazard Potential of Chemicals, and is an active member of the NFPA 68 - NFPA 69 committee for Explosion Protection Systems, and NFPA 654 - NFPA 664 committee for Handling and Conveying of Dusts, Vapors, and Gases. He serves on the Editorial Board of Process Safety Progress, and the Editorial Board of the Journal of Loss Prevention in the Process Industries. He is an author of the Explosion Prevention and Protection chapter of the NFPA Handbook of Fire Protection.

Topic: **An Introduction to Combustible Dust Hazards and OSHA NEP:**
Combustible dust hazards (fires and explosions) can lead to injuries, fatalities, property damage and business interruptions in facilities handling powders and bulk solids. Recently, OSHA initiated the Combustible Dust National Emphasis Program (NEP) to systematically inspect these facilities. This presentation will provide an overview of combustible dust hazards, OSHA NEP, and modern methods used for hazard identification and hazard mitigation.

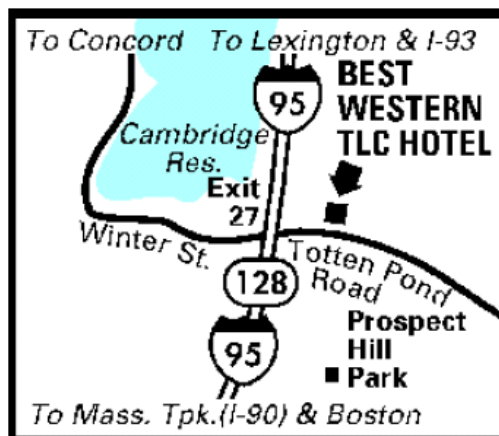
