Paul Locke

Mr. Locke has been with the MA Department of Environmental Protection since 1987 and is currently the Director for Response & Remediation in the Bureau of Waste Site Cleanup, overseeing implementation of the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (including audits, compliance & enforcement and data management systems) as well as the Federal Sites section.

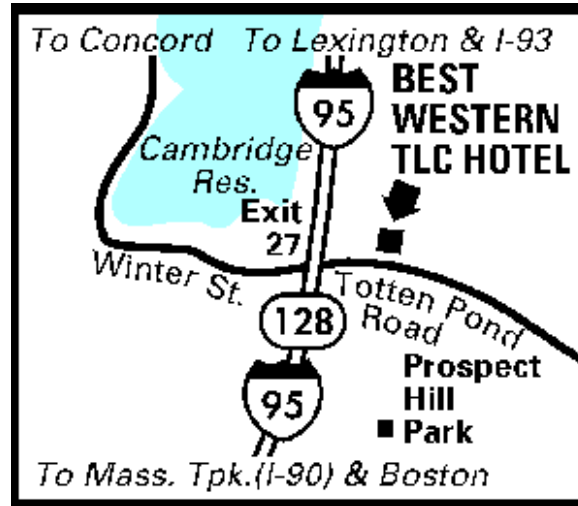
Since 2002, Paul had been the Director of Policy and Program Development, during which time MassDEP promulgated significant revisions to the MCP and first-in-the-nation standards for perchlorate. Before joining Waste Site Cleanup in 2002, Paul was head of the Risk Analysis Group within the MA DEP Office of Research and Standards, where he participated in environmental policy development, review of site specific reports, and provided technical assistance to DEP staff and the regulated community. Mr. Locke has participated in numerous revisions to the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (310 CMR 40), including the development of the privatized program. He is the primary author of the MCP Subpart I regulations on human and environmental risk characterization and is co-author of the Department's Guidance for Disposal Site Risk Characterization.

Mr. Locke holds a Bachelor's degree in Chemistry from Harvard College and a Master's degree in Civil Engineering from the Tufts University program in Public Health.
