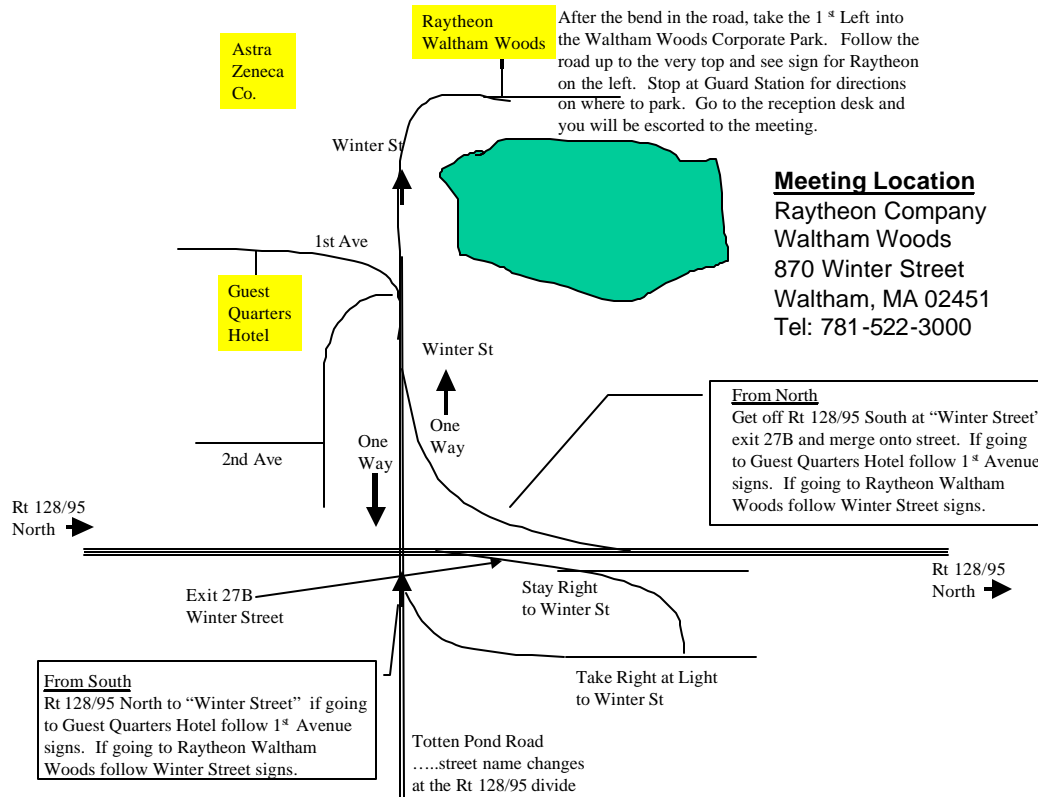
## Speaker Biographies

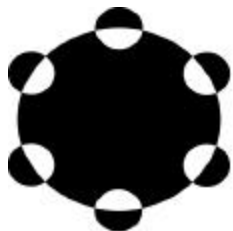
### **Thelma Murphy**
