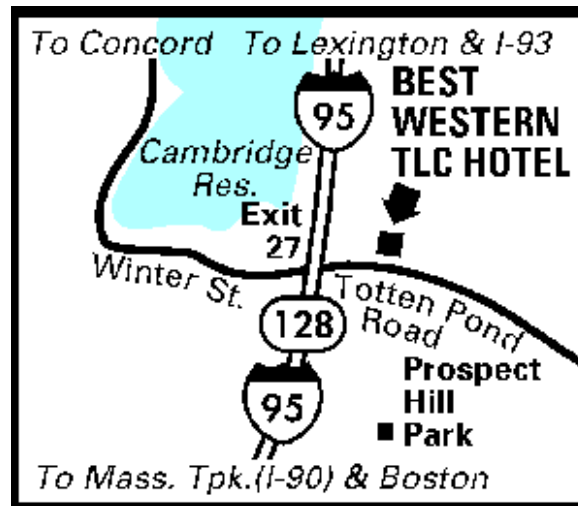
The New England Chapter of ACHMM (NEACHMM) and the Massachusetts Office of Technical Assistance (OTA) have developed a program to assist Massachusetts educators at the Junior High and Senior High School level to properly procure, manage, and dispose of hazardous materials used within their laboratories and facilities. To support this program, NEACHMM received a grant to **recruit and provide training to NEACHMM members** who wish to participate. The program includes initial training on conducting laboratory and facility audits and directing schools to the resources they need to reduce the health hazards and environmental risks of maintaining old, unused chemicals.

We have asked **Dr. Dwight Peavey**, TRI Coordinator for EPA Region 1, specialist in the management of hazardous and toxic chemicals, to be our guest speaker at the next NEACHMM General Meeting. Dr. Peavey has led teams of EPA staff and student interns in assisting nine communities in implementing chemical management programs in their schools.
