**RCRA Reform for Colleges and Universities:** On December 1, 2008 EPA published 40 CFR 262.200 - .216, Subpart K, "Alternative Requirements for Hazardous Waste Determination and Accumulation of Unwanted Material for Laboratories Owned by Eligible Academic Entities." This rule provides colleges, universities, and university-affiliated medical institutions flexibility in managing Satellite Accumulation Areas in laboratories, including increased time to move waste to the Main Accumulation Area and the choice to delay making the hazardous waste determination until waste is transported to the MAA.

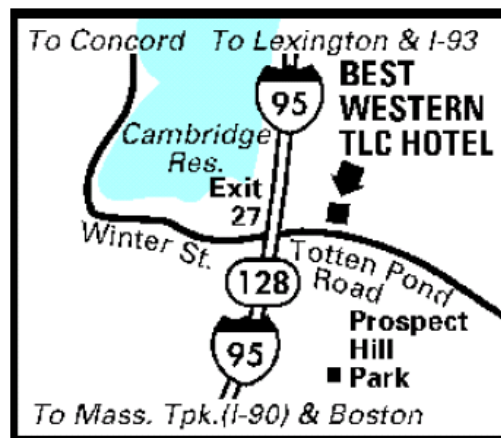
